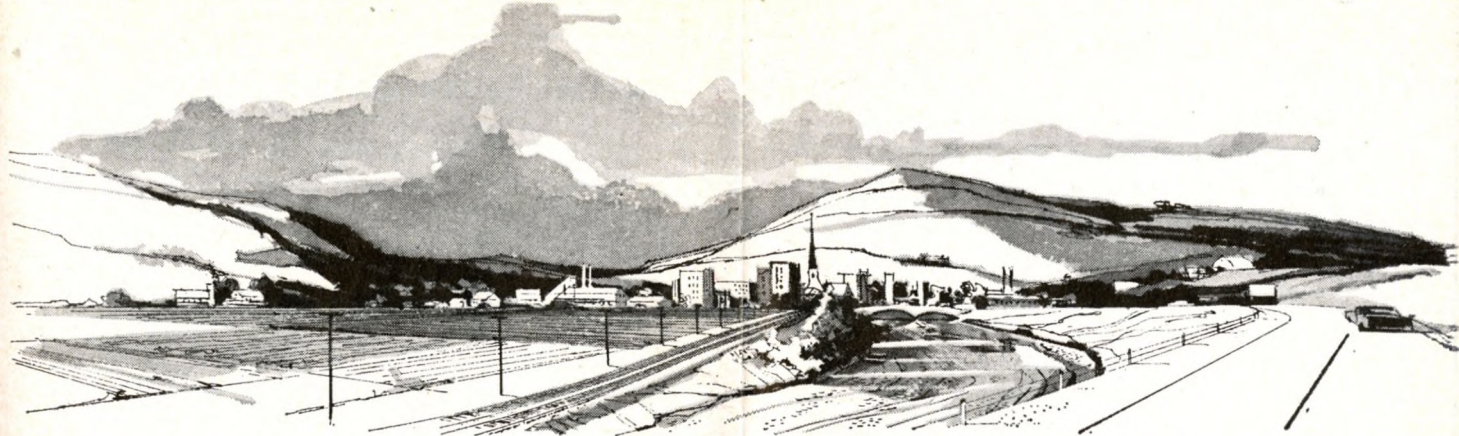

GENERAL INFORMATION

TO OBTAIN COMPLETE INFORMATION FROM THESE TIME TABLES, OBSERVE THE FOLLOWING GENERAL RULES:

ALL REFERENCE MARKS IN TIME TABLES SHOULD BE NOTED VERY CAREFULLY.

STANDARD OF TIME—Rock Island trains east of Phillipsburg, Kan., and Tucumcari, N. M., are run by **Central Standard Time**; west of Phillipsburg, Kan., and Tucumcari, N. M., by **Mountain Standard Time**. Yuma and west, **Pacific Standard Time**. Time from 12.01 midnight to 12.00 noon (A. M. time) is shown in light figures; time from 12.01 noon to 12.00 midnight (P. M. time) is shown in dark figures.

The time shown opposite a station name is the time trains are scheduled to be at such station. Where neither "A." nor "P." appears opposite a station name, the time of PASSENGER trains opposite such a station will be considered both the arriving and the leaving time. Where no time is shown, trains do not stop.

STATION INDEX on page 3. The NUMBERS SHOWN IN STATION INDEX indicate TABLES.

In many tables you will find pairs of ruled lines with one or more stations intervening. Such rules indicate that stations thus set apart are located on lines branching out from the line covered by the table. If your destination is on the main line of the table, and not on one of these branching lines, let your eye jump both rules in tracing your schedule.

CONDENSED SCHEDULES—TABLES A to F, are of assistance in planning local as well as extended trips. EQUIPMENT of through trains is shown on page 14.

Leg rest seat coaches are assigned on certain trains. Every effort is made to maintain this service, but operation of non-leg rest coaches may be necessary on occasions, due to emergencies or shortages.

On trains that carry chair car porters, there is no charge for the service of the porter. He will, however, collect a nominal charge for pillows except on trains 3 and 4.

NOT RESPONSIBLE—No responsibility is assumed for errors in time tables, inconvenience or damage resulting from delayed trains or failure to make connections; schedules herein are subject to change without notice.

BUY TICKETS before boarding trains and avoid payment of extra charge.

Stopovers are permitted at all points where trains are scheduled to stop, within final limit of tickets, by notifying conductor. Stopovers are not permitted at Lawrence, Kansas.

ADJUSTMENT OF FARES—Should any difference arise with Conductors or Agents pay the fare required, take receipt and communicate with Passenger Traffic Manager, Rock Island Lines, Room 723 La Salle Station, Chicago 5, Ill.

REDEMPTION OF TICKETS—Application for redemption of unused portion of tickets should be made to Mr. H. J. Koukal, Passenger Traffic Manager, Rock Island Lines, Room 723 La Salle Station, Chicago 5, Ill. The unused portion of tickets issued by other roads should be sent to General Passenger Agent of issuing road.

TICKETS MUST BE USED WITHIN TIME LIMIT—Tickets will not be accepted for passage after midnight of expiration date indicated on the ticket except that where passenger boards train prior to midnight of date ticket expires and ticket will expire enroute, or passenger will use train leaving not later than 4.00 A. M. (Standard Time) of the day following date of expiration of ticket, the ticket will be honored for continuous passage without stopover to passenger's destination.

HONORING OF TICKETS—Coach tickets are honored in coaches only. First-class tickets are honored in coaches without additional charge, also in standard sleepers and parlor cars upon payment of additional charge for space occupied.

CHANGING CLASS OF TICKETS—Passengers holding coach tickets who desire to use higher type of accommodations may have their tickets made valid in such type of accommodations on payment of additional charges shown in tariffs lawfully on file. Consult the ticket agent or conductor regarding the amount of the charge.

Passengers will also be required to pay the sleeping or parlor car rate for space occupied.

CHILDREN who are less than five years old are carried free when accompanied by parents or guardians. Those who have reached or passed their fifth birthday and are under twelve years of age, require a half ticket except that adult passage ticket is required where a child has exclusive occupancy of certain Sleeping Car space. **Children of half-fare age when unaccompanied by parents or guardian will only be accepted under certain circumstances and then only when arrangements are made in advance. Consult your ticket agent.** Those who have reached or passed their twelfth birthday require a full ticket. Conductors are not allowed to vary from this rule.

Any person who, because of mental, physical or other disability, is incapable of properly caring for himself or herself, will be received as a passenger ONLY when accompanied by a competent attendant.

HONORING ARRANGEMENTS VIA C. R. I. & P. R. R.

All *one-way tickets* good for passage between Chicago, Ill., and Lawrence, Kan., or points beyond; *one-way interline tickets* good for passage between Chicago and Kansas City, Mo.; and *round-trip tickets* good for passage between Davenport, Ia., and points east, and Kansas City and points beyond; will be honored via direct line through Fairfield or via Des Moines, Ia.

Round trip tickets good for passage between Chicago, Kansas City, Omaha and stations east of Tucumcari, N. M., and points beyond will be honored via Texhoma or Texola, Okla., or Oklahoma City and Texola, Okla.

Tickets between Wellington, Kan., and points north or east and Amarillo and points beyond, good for passage via El Reno, will be honored via Oklahoma City if desired.

Tickets reading between Kingfisher, Okla., and points north, and Chickasha, Okla., and points south, will be honored via direct line or via Oklahoma City.

Tickets to and from Fort Sill or Lawton, Okla., for honoring arrangements via bus, see Page 13.

Numerous other optional, diverse and honoring arrangements are also available.

NOTE 1—Tickets will not be sold between Lawrence, Kan., and stations in Colorado and stations west thereof or to or from California. Stop-overs are not permitted at Lawrence.

GENERAL INFORMATION—Continued

RESERVATIONS

Advance reservations may be made three months in advance of date of departure.

A time limit will be placed on all reservations held in name.

In order to secure refund Sleeping Car tickets must be canceled the day before departure.

If further information is desired, any Rock Island Agent or Representative will be glad to assist you.

BAGGAGE

Rock Island Stations to and from which baggage may be checked are indicated in Index of Folder on page 3.

A service charge of 25 cents for each piece of hand baggage and 50 cents for each trunk or large piece of baggage checked will be made to cover cost of handling. The service charge will be collected at time of checking.

For accommodation of patrons, arrangements are in effect at all principal points for checking baggage from hotel or residence to destination station, or to hotel or residence at destination. Patrons who desire this service should request same of agent at starting point. A standard charge per piece is made for this special service.

CHECK BAGGAGE A DAY IN ADVANCE to be sure it is at your destination on your arrival.

Checkable baggage consists of wearing apparel, toilet articles and such personal effects as the passenger may need for use on the trip.

Money, Jewelry, negotiable papers, liquids, fragile or perishable articles, radios, typewriters, dishes and household goods are examples of some of the articles not checkable as baggage. Consult agent.

NOT RESPONSIBLE—The Rock Island Railroad will not be responsible for the loss of unchecked baggage when taken into sleeping cars or chair cars by patrons and will assume no responsibility for unchecked articles left in stations, on platforms, or in cars.

PROTECT YOUR LUGGAGE AND WEARING APPAREL—For passenger's own protection all baggage to be checked should bear owner's name and address in a plain and legible manner.

BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE AND LIMITATIONS—150 lbs. of baggage will be allowed on each full fare ticket and 75 lbs. on each half fare ticket without payment of excess weight charges unless otherwise specified in tariff. Baggage weighing in excess of these allowances will be subject to excess weight charges. EXCEPT—a total of 300 lbs. of baggage will be allowed on each FAMILY plan ticket before excess weight charges apply. Passengers holding TRANS-PACIFIC tickets are allowed 350 lbs. of baggage on each whole ticket and 175 lbs. on each half fare ticket before excess weight charges apply. Any one piece of baggage weighing over 300 lbs. (except immigrant baggage and public entertainment paraphernalia) will not be accepted for checking—must be sent by express.

EXCESS BAGGAGE—Baggage in excess of the regular allowance will be charged for at published tariff rates. Passenger may declare EXCESS VALUE on baggage at time of checking at a nominal charge for each \$100 or fraction thereof, limited to \$2500 for one passenger.

Baggage, household pets and remains will be checked and handled to and from all stop points on all trains subject to tariff rules and regulations and legal restrictions, except as follows:

GOLDEN STATE, trains 3 and 4—baggage will be carried under check in the usual manner between Chicago, Englewood, Bureau, Moline, Rock Island, Kansas City, Topeka, Herlington, Hutchinson, Pratt, Liberal, El Paso, Douglas, Tucson, Chandler, Phoenix, Palm Springs and Los Angeles.

Checked baggage will not be handled on trains 23, 24, 27 and 28.

PEORIA ROCKETS, trains 11 and 13, will handle remains, checked baggage, and household pets from stop points between Chicago and La Salle to Peoria only. Trains 12 and 14 will handle remains, checked baggage and household pets from Peoria to stop points La Salle to Chicago.

On all trains except 7 and 10 remains, pets and checked baggage from and to Davenport must be handled via Rock Island.

Checked baggage including pets and remains will be handled from and to **MOLINE, ILL.** on trains 3, 4, 7 and 10 only.

Sleeping Car passengers arriving Chicago on Train No. 4, **GOLDEN STATE** or No. 8 the **ROCKY MOUNTAIN ROCKET**, may check hand baggage to taxi-stand for nominal fee of 35c per bag. Claim check is issued by Sleeping Car Porter.

GOLDEN STATE or ROCKY MOUNTAIN ROCKET passengers may have their hand luggage transferred in Chicago, to or from Sleeping Car space on the Capitol Limited, Twentieth Century Limited, New England States, Broadway Limited, or the General, at charge of 75c per piece. Sleeping Car porter will provide special transfer tags.

Passengers transferring in **Kansas City, Mo.**, may have hand luggage transferred to reserved space on outbound train at charge of 15c when layover period is one hour or less; 40c per piece when layover is in excess of one hour, but not to exceed 24 hours.

BAGGAGE ON OWATONNA-ROCHESTER BUS—Only ordinary hand luggage can be handled which is free to patrons of the Bus Service. All heavy luggage including trunks must, because of limited space in luggage compartment, be forwarded by express.

PREPAID TICKET ORDER SERVICE

Tickets for rail, sleeping and parlor car, also cash for meals or other incidentals, may be prepaid and will be handled for you by your railroad agent.

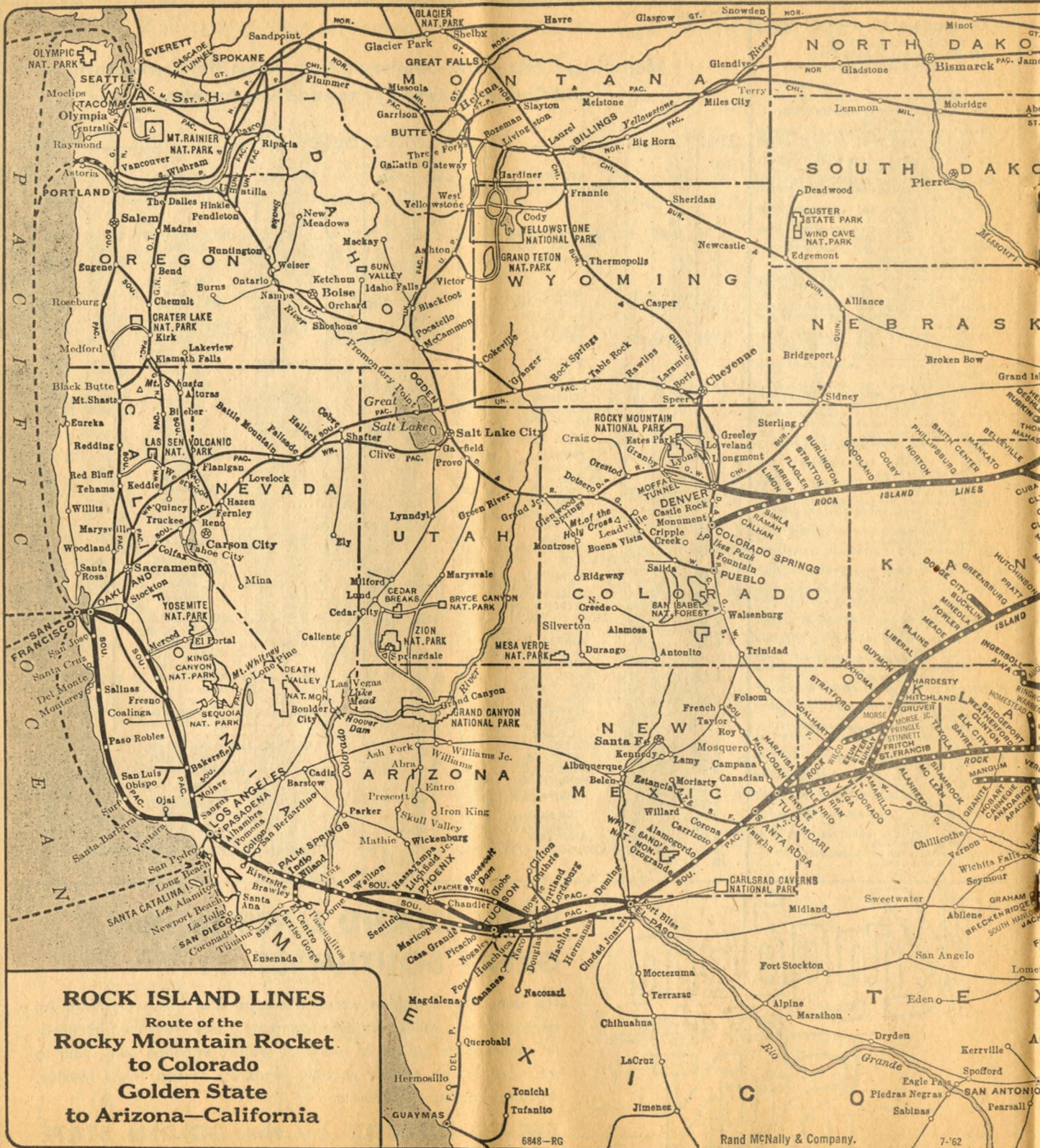
