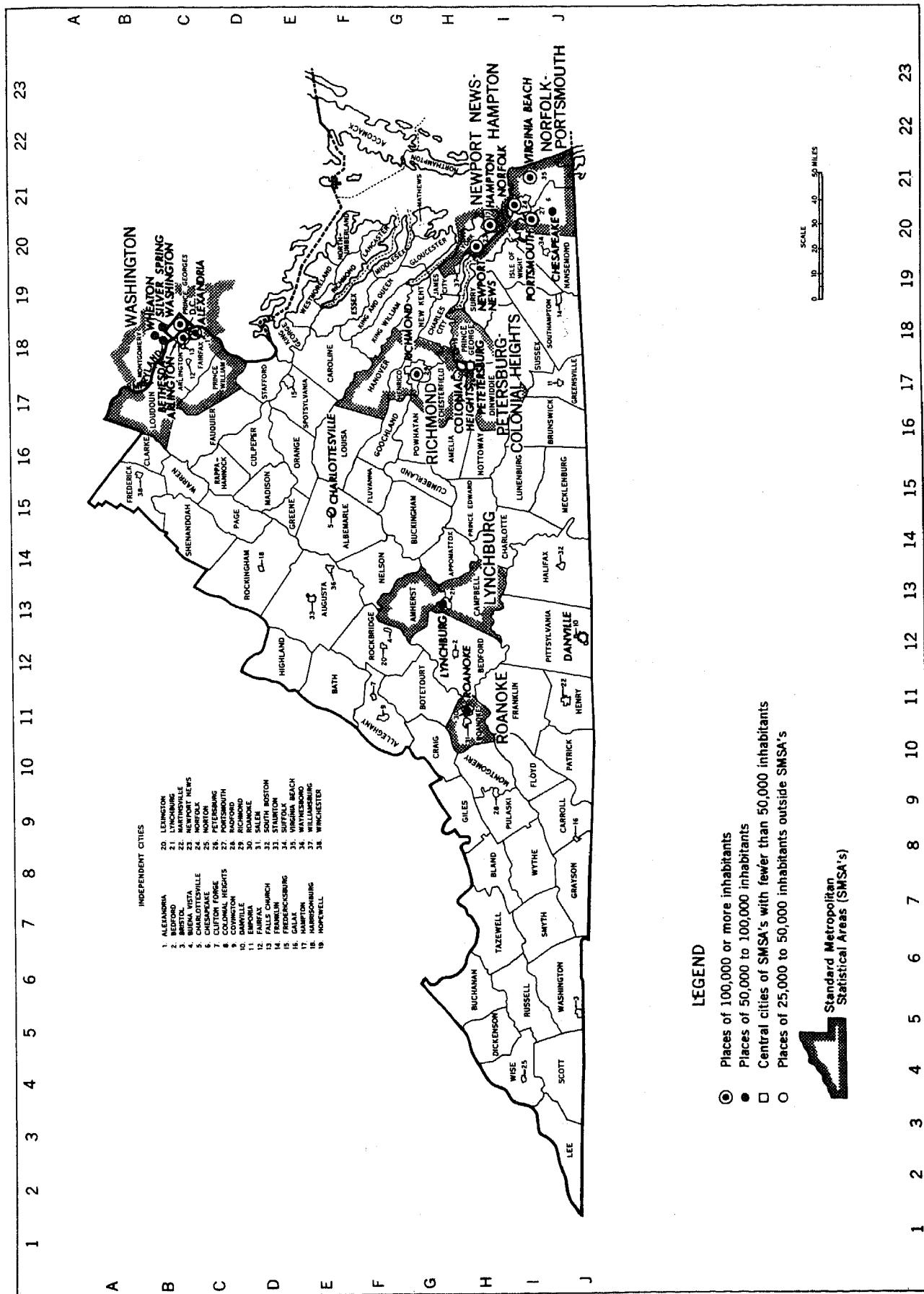

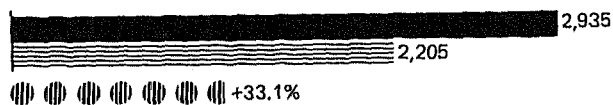

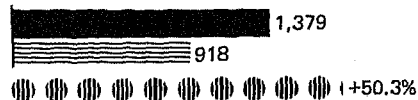

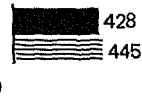

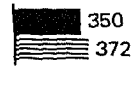

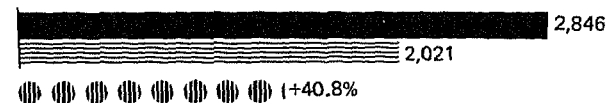

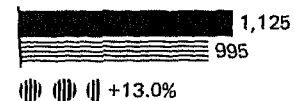

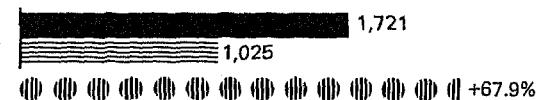

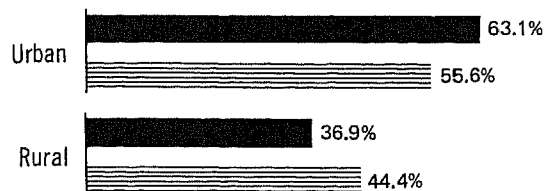

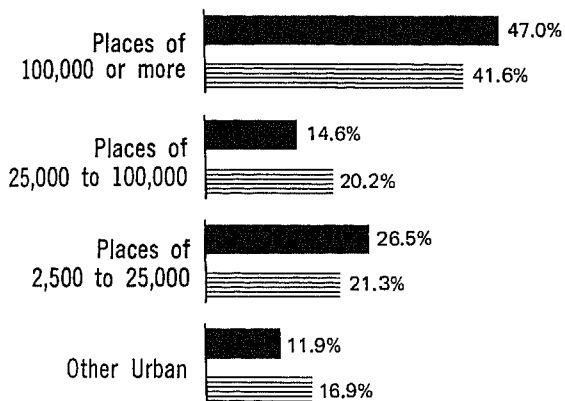
Percent Distribution by Place of Residence

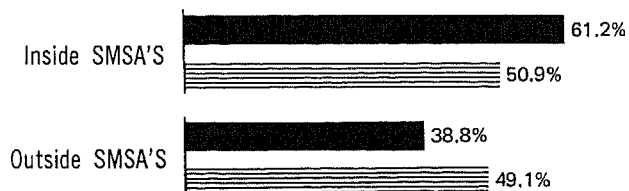

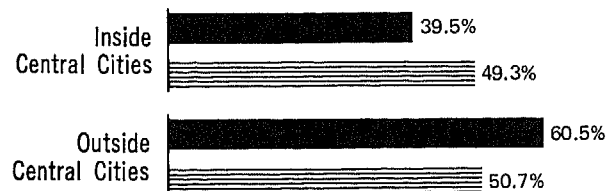

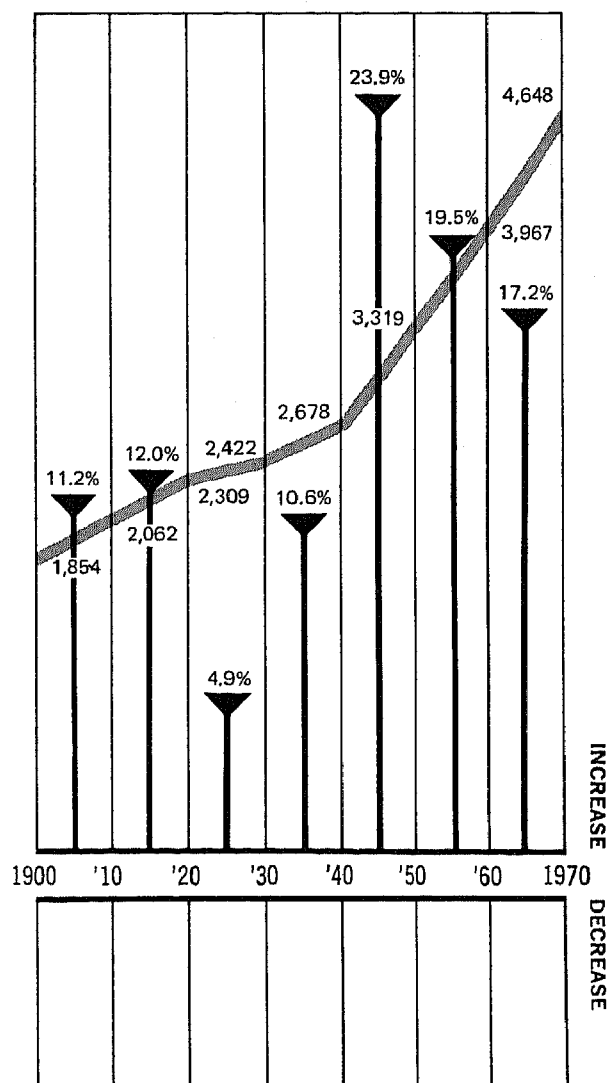
